STANDING ORDERS GOVERNING CAMPAIGNS AND DEMOCRACY OFFICER

1. <u>Interpretation</u>

These Standing Orders shall be read in conjunction with the Constitution, Bye Laws and the relevant Standing Orders of Hull University Union and shall be interpreted accordingly.

2. <u>Aims</u>

- a) To have a dual role and be responsible for both the running of Semester long campaigns and ensuring the democratic processes of HUU are followed correctly;
- b) To coordinate campus wide campaigns in coordination with the relevant Sabbatical Officers;
- c) To assist the President and relevant Sabbatical Officer(s) with delivery of the priority campaign;
- d) To ensure referenda are advertised and details given to Marketing for both promotion and voting;
- e) To liaise with the Local Council to increase student participation in elections.
- f) To spend at least two days per semester on the Scarborough Campus.
- g) To have a thorough knowledge of HUU's Constitution, Byelaws and Standing Orders and liaise with the Sabbatical Officers over the amending or writing of Standing Orders to ensure they are compatible with HUU's regulations.

3. <u>Election</u>

The Campaigns and Democracy Officer shall be elected in accordance with Hull University Union election regulations¹.

5. <u>Internal</u>

The Campaigns and Democracy Officer shall be:

- a. Voting Member of:
 - (i) The Governance Zone.

6. <u>External</u>

The Campaigns and Democracy Officer shall represent the Union to the University on the following committees; sub-committees; groups and panels:

7. <u>Budget</u>

The Campaigns and Democracy Officer shall have responsibility for the following budget heads in conjunction with the President:

- a. Campaigns;
- b. Elections;
- c. Union Council;
- d. General Meetings.
