RULES AND REGULATIONS OF EXTERNAL WEBSITES

SECTION 1. - INTERPRETATION

These Standing Orders shall be read in conjunction with the Articles, ByeLaws and the relevant Standing Orders of Hull University Union.

SECTION 2. - CONTENT

Societies have the permission to operate an external website/online group if they abide by the following rules and regulations:

- 1) The President/Chair of the Society is to liaise with the President of Activities concerning website content.
- 2) The President/Chair of the Society is to sign the Guidelines on Defamation document. If it is deemed that there has been a case for defamation, the Society President, at the discretion of the Council (and in vacation, the Union Executive Committee), may be removed and held accountable.
- 3) The President of Activities is to have access to website content at all times enabling changes to be made if deemed necessary. The President of Activities must be made an administrator of the group if this option is available.
- 4) There is to be both a link from Hull University Union's website; namely Hullstudent.com, to the relevant Society's website, with the link not disclosing the Society website address, and a link from the Society's website to Hull University Union's website where Hullstudent.com shall be named.
- 5) Members of Society's Executive Committee shall be the only persons authorised to input information and update data on the Society's website. The President may liaise directly with the President of Activities in times of emergency.
