STANDING ORDER GOVERNING THE BLACK, ASIAN AND MINORITY ETHNIC (BAME) **STUDENTS' REPRESENTATIVE**

1. Interpretation

These Standing Orders shall be read in conjunction with the Constitution, Bye Laws and the relevant Standing Orders of Hull University Students' Union (HUSU) and shall be interpreted accordingly.

2. Status of Officer

The BAME Students' Representative shall be responsible for representing the interests of BAME students at the University of Hull. The BAME Students' Representative is responsible to the President of Inclusivity and Diversity.

3. Election

The BAME Students' Representative shall be elected in accordance with Hull University Students' Union election regulations in SO 8001. They will be elected once per academic year through union-wide elections and voted for by students who self-define as members of a minority ethnic group in the United Kingdom.

4. Duties

The BAME Students' Representative will:

- a. Represent interests of minority groups within the union by organising campaigns to address BAME issues within HUSU and the University of Hull;
- b. Signpost BAME students on specific issues to receive help and assistance;
- c. Promote links with other similar groups and organisations, within the local community, regional area and nationally;
- d. Be a member of Union Council and the Inclusivity and Diversity Zone with full voting rights.
