Title of motion: Increase Co-ordination Between Hull University Students' Union and The University

What do you want to change?

I would like the Hull University Students' Union (HUSU) to work with the university over how HUSU services are advertised, especially during open days and University Induction.

Why do you want to change it?

This year especially HUSU was given a lot less support during the University Induction, which was noticeable with how a tiny proportion of students having seen the online videos that were meant to be shown to students.

What do you want Hull University Students' Union to do?

I would like HUSU to continually monitor student engagement and lobby the university to:

- Promote HUSU services and the work of the Presidents, Part Time Officers and volunteers.
- Including HUSU newsletter in the University bulletin
- Incorporating HUSU promotional videos into Open Days, University Induction and Introductory lectures
- Ensuring students know that the Students' Union and the Advice Centre is independent of the University
- Ensuring the University recognises the work of the Course Rep system through the Student-Staff partnership
- HUSU related webpage within the University website
