All leisurewear must be purchased from them. “One of my committee is no longer a student, can they still be on committee?” – unfortunately not, however they can still become an associate member of your club. “Once of my committee members has dropped out, can we double up on committee positions?” – yes as long as they are not Pres, Treas or Sec.
