3. VP Education Update

VPE began with an update on the "Shape and Size" proposals that have been discussed across the Education Zone and the representational changes that could take place as a consequence at HUU. There have been discussions with the VPA and the President of the ISA to dissolve the ISA in its current format and give international students more of a voice on academic matters. VPE is currently heading up a Shape and Size Task Group along with the University Registrar, to identify the impact the transition would potentially have on students.

VPE is also preparing the handover pack for his successor and also mapping out changes to Union governance based on the Governance Review in tandem with GDC.

Furthermore, VPE is working with Teaching Enhanced Learning (TEL) on how best to implement Canvas and is involved in discussion involving the enhancement of the iHull app. Finally, VPE is working on a Student Attendance and Engagement Project which will allow students and staff to view the level of engagement for each individual student. This is to make Visa compliance easier to handle and also so staff can see which students are engaged and which are not. This will help with retention.
