



HULL UNIVERSITY STUDENTS' UNION CODE OF CONDUCT

Application of this Code of Conduct

The Hull University Students' Union (HUSU) Code of Conduct applies to all individual members of Hull University Students' Union, and all Student groups* which are recognised and defined by the Articles, Bye-laws and Standing Orders of the Hull University Students' Union (hereafter referred to as HUSU).


(*Student groups is a term used to define any constituted or constituted group associated with HUSU including, but not limited to, Sports clubs and Societies.)

Conduct of Members

Members shall conduct themselves towards all other Members, and staff of HUSU, and all students and staff of the University of Hull in a manner which is deemed to be acceptable at any and all times that they are:

1. acting in the course of, or in connection with, any activity conducted under the names of the University of Hull, HUSU or any Student group which is recognised by HUSU; and/or
2. acting in the course of, or in connection with, any activity publicised under the names of the University of Hull, HUSU, or any Student group which is recognised by HUSU; and/or
3. acting in the course of, or in connection with, any meetings held within the remit of the Articles, Bye-laws or Standing Orders governing HUSU; and/or
4. acting in the course of, or in connection with, any activity funded by the University of Hull, HUSU, or any Student group which is recognised by HUSU; and/or
5. utilising any equipment which is the property of the University of Hull, HUSU, or any Student group which is recognised by HUSU; and/or
6. using any transport booked via the University of Hull, HUSU, or any Student group which is recognised by HUSU; and/or
7. attending any of HUSU's licenced premises as an individual member or as a member of a student group which is recognised by HUSU.

and shall at all times conduct themselves in such a way as not to bring into disrepute the names of the University of Hull, HUSU, or any Student group which is recognised by HUSU.



Behaviour which is deemed to be unacceptable shall include, but not be limited to, behaviour which is discriminatory, abusive, offensive, defamatory, distressing, aggressive, threatening, coercive or intimidating.


Any Member of HUSU who fails to comply with the provisions of this Code of Conduct shall be subject to disciplinary action including, but not limited to, suspension or withdrawal of Membership of HUSU, in accordance with the provisions of HUSU Disciplinary Policy.

Compliance with Health and Safety Procedures

All Members of HUSU shall have regard to and comply with any and all requirements, regulations or conditions relating to Health and Safety and the reporting of incidents which may be applicable, including any and all requirements, regulations or conditions applied by the University of Hull and HUSU, at all times where they are:

1. acting in the course of, or in connection with, any activity conducted under the names of the University of Hull or HUSU a Student group; and/or
2. acting in the course of, or in connection with, any activity publicised under the names of the University of Hull, HUSU, any Student group which is recognised by HUSU; and/or
3. acting in the course of, or in connection with, any meetings held within the remit of the Articles, Bye-laws or Standing orders governing HUSU; and/or
4. acting in the course, of or in connection with, any activity funded by the University of Hull, or any Student group which is recognised by HUSU; and/or
5. utilising any equipment which is the property of the University of Hull, HUSU, or any Student group which is recognised by HUSU; and/or
6. using any transport booked via the University of Hull, HUSU, or any Student group which is recognised by HUSU; and/or
7. attending any of HUSU's licenced premises as an individual member or as a member of any Student group which is recognised by HUSU.

The Committee of any Student group which is recognised by HUSU shall be responsible for ensuring that any and all activities by, or conducted in, the name of such Student group have regard to, and comply with, any and all requirements, regulations or conditions relating to health and safety and the reporting of incidents which may be applicable, including



any and all requirements, regulations or conditions applied by the University of Hull, HUSU or any governing body, to which a Student group is affiliated to.

Context and Interpretation

All Members of HUSU, including all members of Student groups which are recognised by HUSU shall adhere to the Articles, Bye-laws, Standing Orders and Policies of HUSU, in addition to the provisions of this Code of Conduct.

Any matters not specifically covered by this Code of Conduct shall be referred to the President of the Students' Union who shall make a ruling, and if the President is unable to make a ruling the matter will be referred by them to Union Council or the Board of Trustees, whose majority decision shall be final.

Nothing in this Code of Conduct shall conflict with the Articles, Bye-laws Standing Orders or Policies of HUSU.

Nothing in the Constitution or Code of Conduct of any recognised Student group shall conflict with this Code of Conduct.
