The International Students Officer is responsible for representing the interests of international students at the University of Hull.

The purpose of the International Students Officer is to be an active force to improve the international student experience. This will include being a member of the Education Zone, working in conjunction and with the support of the President of Education. The post-holder is expected to contribute with feedback from other international students and innovative ideas to solve pressing issues.

Key responsibilities

- Attend Union Council and Education Zone meetings;
- Be a member of University Senate;
- Represent and support international students and act as a channel of communication between them, the Union and the University;
- Increase international student involvement in the Union activities and structures;
- Engage international students in the policy developments of Union Council;
- Engage others in the views of international students.
