



UNION COUNCIL MOTION

M.1819 – 11 Motion to add a new role to the Education Zone:
HYMS Part-Time Officer (HYMS – Hull York Medical School)

HUU Notes:

Historically HYMS have been very much considered their own 'entity' with minimal engagement from Hull University Union. HYMS also have their own academic representative structure which further isolates HYMS students from engaging with the Union. Therefore, HYMS students are not represented effectively by Hull University Union.

HUU Believes:

1. HYMS students are not represented effectively by Hull University Union – HYMS students have their own academic representation structure (does not feed into Hull University Union)
2. From NSS comments, HYMS students often feel like they do not belong to either University (York or Hull) due to their degree being split between two campuses.
3. President of Education sits on the HYMS Joint Senate but does not have engagement with HYMS students – not good representation.
4. A HYMS Part-Time Officer position would ensure that HYMS students are represented effectively by Hull University Union and that HYMS students do not feel isolated from the Union.

HUU Resolves:

1. To create the position of a HYMS Part-Time Officer position in the Education Zone.
2. The HYMS Part-Time Officer will have a vote in the Education Zone and on Union Council.
3. A separate standing order is created to reflect this position (see attached)
