M.1819 – 6 Mandating UEC to Lobby Trustee Board to make HUU a Living Wage Employer

HUU Notes:

Many Students, particularly those from Working Class Backgrounds require flexible part time employment in order to live.

Many of these choose to work for HUU, whether it be with ents, Spar or Bars & Catering.

Currently Three students working the same length shift can earn three different wages for the same work

HUU Believes:

All staff working for HUU should, at minimum be paid a minimum of the government defined national living wage for Over 25s (NLW).

HUU Resolves:

UEC be mandated to lobby the HUU Board of Trustees to bring staff wage in line with NLW.

A member of UEC should update the council on the progress of their endeavours in this regard.
