



# UNION COUNCIL MOTION

M.1819 – 12 This motion is to add a new role to the Education Zone for a Foundation Year part time officer to represent all students in foundation year courses across the University.

## HUU Notes:

Currently, we have limited representation for foundation students especially with the lack of course reps. Issues, feedback and comments are not being brought to attention and students feel like they are not part of the community.

## HUU Believes:

A part time officer for Foundation students will increase representation and will ensure that issues are being heard and resolved. It is very difficult for Faculty Reps to focus their attention just on one year; therefore an officer for foundation students will not only ease the work load but will also ensure better and more specific representation.

## HUU Resolves:

We propose that a Foundation year student officer is elected in the by-elections to be part of the Education zone and represent all foundation students. We would like the officer to be a voting member of the Union Council and influence change.

Faculty Reps and Education zone president will be responsible for recruitment and FSE rep will be responsible for writing the standing orders. Action will be taken as soon as possible if this motion is passed. The officer will be co-opted in the next Union Council meeting.

The Foundation Year Student officer will be supported by Foundation Year Reps from each faculty.
