Core Purpose

The President of Sport is the President of the Athletic Union. The President of Sport is responsible for the management, provision and representation of Sport at University of Hull Union. The President of Sport is head of the Sport Zone and is to liaise with its officers on a regular basis.

Description of Specific Duties

In representing Hull University Union's members the President of Sport regularly reports on progress through media with particular emphasis on the successes achieved for both individual and groups of students.

Particular duties include:

- Represent students on sports-related issues;
- Engage with students on a regular basis;
- Support part-time Officers and fellow Presidents with their projects;
- Run campaigns on student issues and assist in campaigns that other officers may be running;
- Ensure that the Sports zone budget is not exceeded;
- Liaise with the Sports Centre on a regular basis;
- Contribute to training of student volunteers and part-time elected officers;
- Organise AU Council;
- Work with the AU Executive committee in organising Varsity, AU Ball and the annual Trophy Presentation;
- Ensure the safety and legality of all AU activities;
- Ensure Hull University Union holds all the insurance policies required by the AU;
- Publicise the AU both within the student body and the wider community;
- Liaise with relevant Hull University Union staff on issues affecting the student body.
