



Trans Students Representative

Aim

The Trans Students Representative shall be responsible for representing the interests of trans students at the University of Hull. The Trans Students Representative is responsible to the President of Welfare and Community.

Key responsibilities

- Attend Union Council, Welfare & Community Zone and LGBT+ Committee meetings with full voting rights;
- Run the Hull University Union Trans Support Group;
- Signpost students seeking help, advice or information to relevant services and organisations;
- Represent the views of trans members of Hull University Union to Hull University Union and the University of Hull;
- Organise campaigns to increase awareness of trans issues within Hull University Union and the University of Hull;
- Work to ensure that the rights and identities of trans students are respected and represented;
- Promote links with other similar groups and organisations, within the local community, regional area and nationally.

Useful skills or characteristics

- Knowledgeable about the trans spectrum and issues faced by trans individuals
- Have a wide outreach with the student body
- Effective time management
- Be adaptable and communicative
- Good organisational skills
- Creativity

Skills you can expect to learn and develop

- Develop communication and liaison skills
- Gain experience organising events and running meetings
- Improve time management skills

On average you will spend between 6-8 hours a week on this role. Some weeks will be more demanding than others.
