

## Environment & Ethics Officer

### Aim

The role is to encourage students to live more sustainably and promote environmentally focussed events at the University of Hull and Hull University Union.

### Key responsibilities

- Attend Union Council and Welfare & Community Zone meetings;
- Educate students at the University of Hull (UoH) on environmental issues, both locally, nationally and globally;
- Educate students at the UoH on ethical issues, both locally, nationally and globally;
- Promote and support active student participation in environmental and ethical campaigns such as Fair Trade Fortnight;
- Organise and run awareness and pressure campaigns to lobby increased environmental and ethical practices by both HUU and UoH;
- Liaise and work with local, national and international organisations over environmental and ethical issues;
- Work towards HUU leading the Student Union movement in both innovation and participation on environmental and ethical issues.

- Have a wide outreach with the student body
- Effective time management
- Be adaptable and communicative
- Good organisational skills
- Creativity

### Skills you can expect to learn and develop

- Develop communication and liaison skills.
